



TSOs – HELP PROTECT YOUR PAYCHECK BY TAKING ACTION NOW

TSOs are deemed excepted or “essential” and must work.

- If Congress fails to fund the government, TSA employees do not get paid, even though we must show up to work.
- During the last government shutdown, TSA employees went 5 weeks without a paycheck. It was difficult for workers to afford to commute to work, pay living expenses and take care of our families.
